The CBCNJ uses its best efforts to respect the privacy of its online visitors. CBCNJ does not collect personal information from individuals unless they provide it voluntarily and knowingly. CBCNJ does not require a registration or any information in order to view the public portion of this site. Only members of the CBCNJ may visit the Members only section of this site.

The CBCNJ only gathers personally identifiable data, such as names, addresses, zip/postal codes, email addresses, etc. when voluntarily submitted by a visitor. This information is used solely by the CBCNJ or other entities who are involved in the operation of this site for internal purposes. Personally identifiable information is only shared with third parties when the person submitting the information authorizes such activity or it is required to by law.

"Cookies"

Visitors should be aware that non-personal information and data may be automatically collected through the use of "cookies." Cookies are small text files a website uses to recognize repeat visitors, facilitate the visitor's ongoing access to and use of the site, and allow a site to track usage behavior and compile aggregate data that will allow content improvements. Cookies are not programs that come onto a visitor's system and damage files. Generally, cookies work by assigning a unique number to the visitor that has no meaning outside the assigning site. If a visitor does not want information collected through the use of cookies, there is a simple procedure in most browsers that allows the visitor to deny or accept the cookie feature. CBCNJ uses "cookie" technology only to obtain non-personal information from its online visitors in order to improve visitors' online experience and facilitate their visit.
